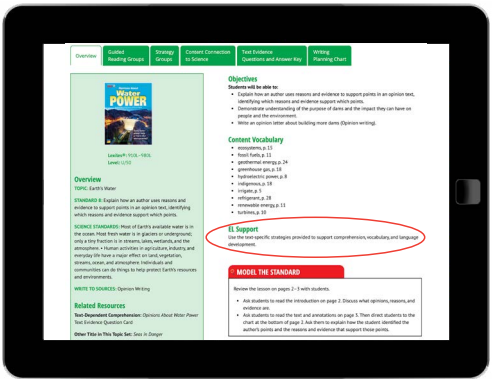

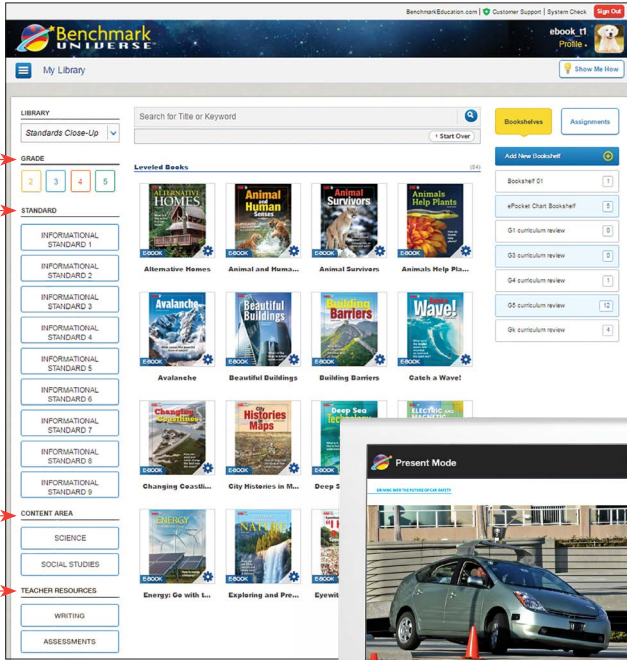

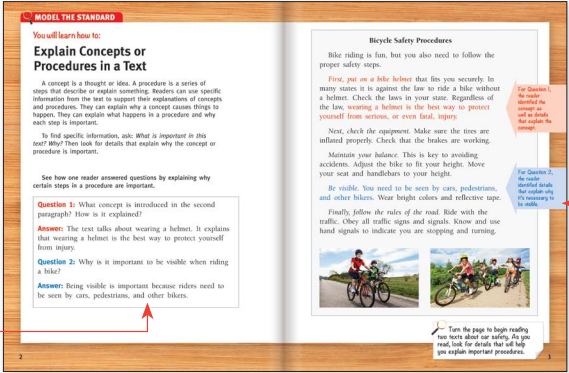

Explore the Key Elements

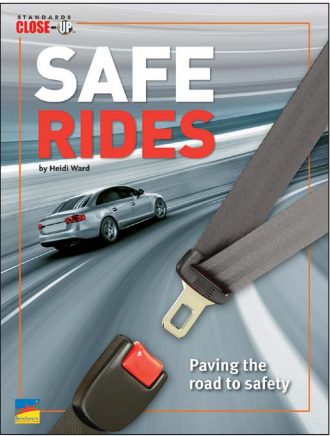
Take a step-by-step tour of the *Standards Close-Up* process and how its components are designed to be used in the classroom, during the regular school year or in summer school.

- 1 Teach a mini-lesson to model the standard.

The lesson features a reading passage with accompanying questions. Sample student responses to questions are provided to guide student thinking and analysis of the text.



Callouts in the margins highlight and explain parts of the text that help students respond to the questions.



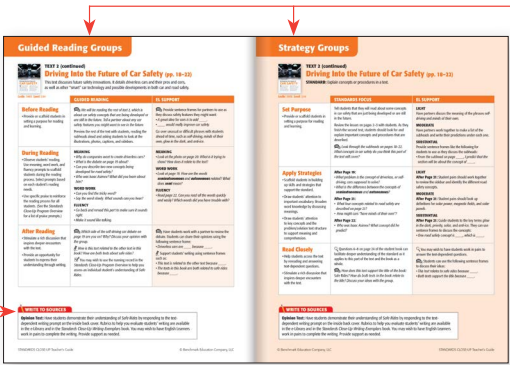
- 4 Answer text-dependent questions designed to address the target reading standard.

Evidence-based questions at the end of each book send readers back to the passages to answer questions that address the target standard.



- 2 For each reading passage, choose a strategy-based lesson plan to teach the standard or a guided reading lesson plan to teach reading skills.

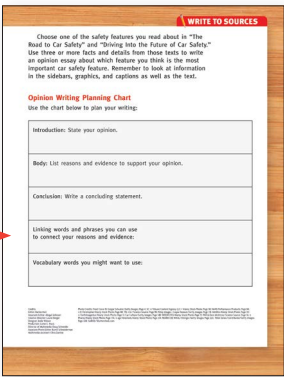
Teacher support for the Write to Sources prompt is included in every book.



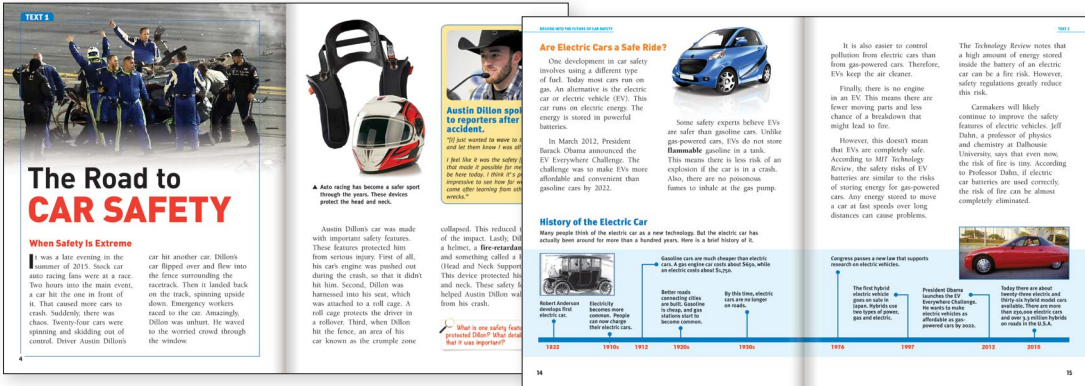
Two-lesson plan options provide flexibility and maximize the instructional use of each reading passage.

- 5 Provide opportunities for opinion, narrative, or informative responses based on readings from the book.

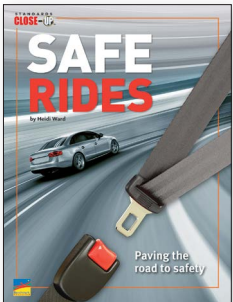

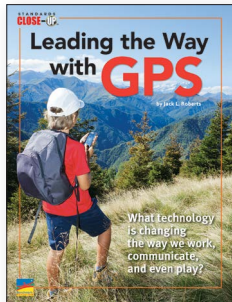

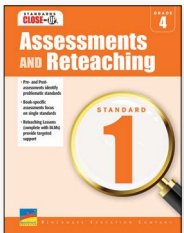

Book 1 Focus: Explain Concepts and Procedures in a Text

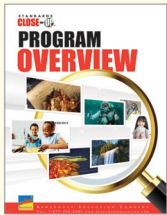


Book 2 Focus: Explain Events and Ideas in a Text



Use the *Assessments and Reteaching* book to monitor progress and reteach as needed.

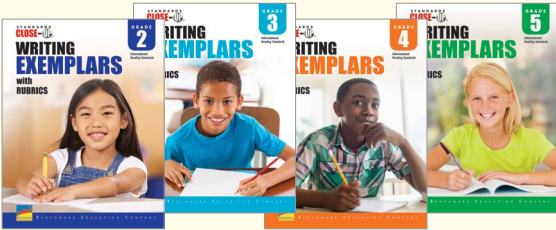
Target Standard: Explain Relationships Within a Text

Writing Exemplars with Rubrics Books provide a range of exemplars for each Write to Sources prompt in the student books, as well as reproducible rubrics and graphic organizers to help students plan their writing. A reproducible exemplar for modeling revision strategies is also included.

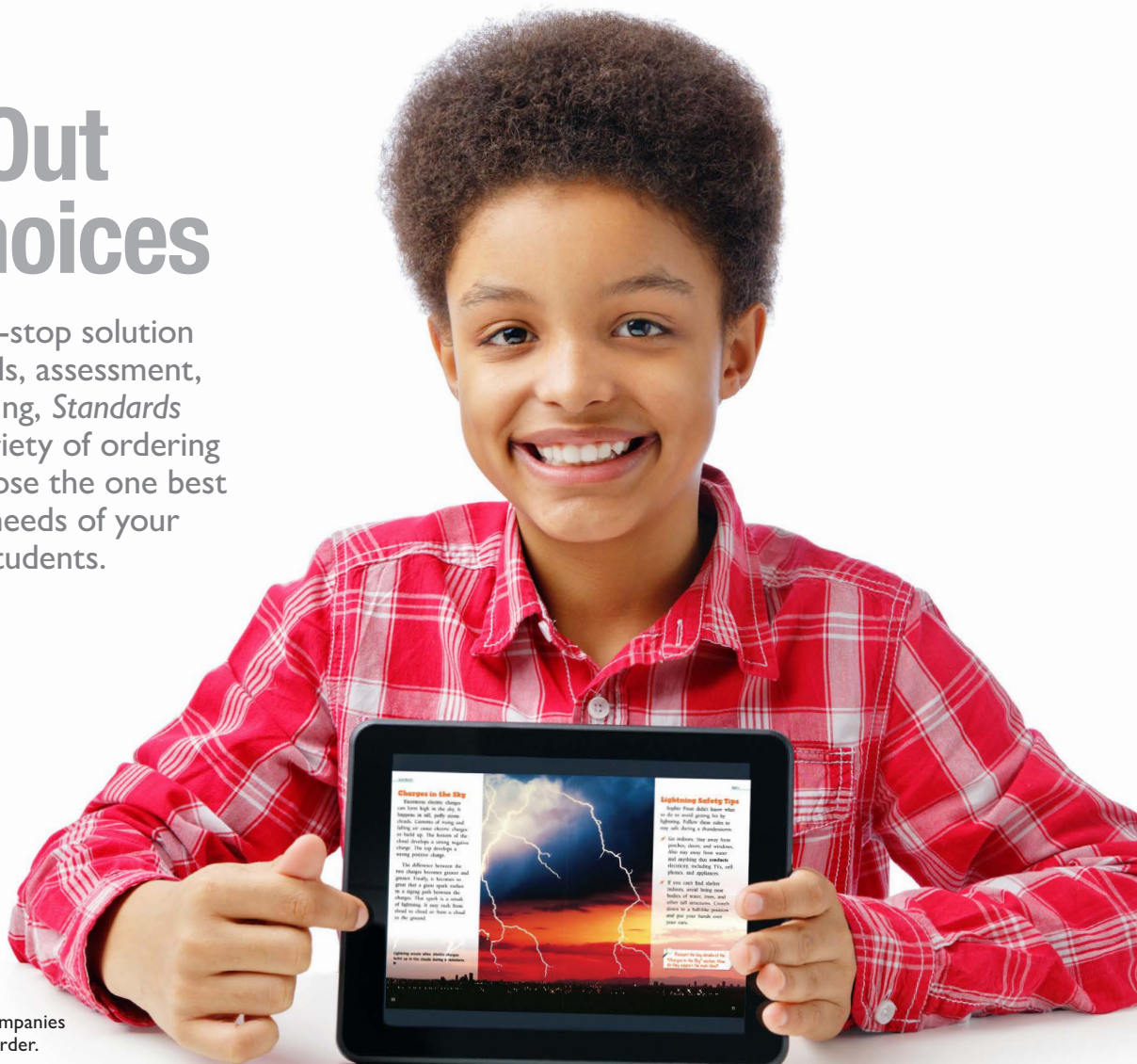
